Week One Camps 06/16/2025 - 06/20/2025

Clay All Day

1:00 PM - 4:00 PM Ages 8-14 \$215/\$225

All new 2025 projects! This All-Clay camp was designed for students who love hands on mixing, molding, texturizing, rolling, and glazing! Each day, we will learn about and use (or make!) a different kind of clay and create cool OOAK art projects! Paper clay, pottery clay, polymer clay, and more! Magic & The Art of Performance

Beginning, Intermediate and Year-Three Magic Camp students are all welcome! PCAC theater art staff joins together with the Ann Arbor Magic Club for a third year of camp for young entertainers! Students will hone their performance arts skills, learn new magic and juggling tricks, while gaining confidence on stage and behind the mic. Our experienced theater staff will guide students in creating their signature moves, catch phrases, costume pieces and magical characteristics, while leading the class with favorite theater games, creative vocal readings, and comedic monologues! Week Two Camps 06/23/2025 - 06/27/2025

Cartooning & Comics - Session One

9:00 AM - Noon Ages 9-15 \$200/\$215

Two sessions this summer! Student artists will learn how to develop their own cartooning and illustration style - line work, lettering, shading and color usage- and then apply the techniques to their own creations. Projects include Anime figures, real-object personification, storytelling thru comics, trading cards, and OG character additions for favorite games or movies.

Creature Feature-Pets!

1:00 PM - 4:00 PM Ages 7-13 \$200/\$215

One of our most popular camps is back for 2025, created for kids who love their pets and it sells out fast! Bring a few pictures of your favorite pet (or outdoor favorite/wild animal) for inspiration if you like - we will have lots of reference materials, too! We will be learning techniques to enhance our realistic animal drawings, think fur, feathers, scales, skin, noses and snouts, as well as create modern art posters, animal themed wearables, and pottery clay water bowls. Each camper will exhibit a piece in our End of Summer Camp Art Show!

Paper Mache All Day!

1:00 PM - 4:00 PM Ages 8-15 \$200/\$215

We will use all kinds of bases, glues and papers to create 2D and 3D art using paper mache! The beginning of the week, we will be preparing our canvases, sculpture forms, glass and wood bases to become dimensional art compositions, 3D sculptures, and cool containers! Textured toweling, colored tissue, vintage stamps and sheet music add interesting details to our forms, while paint, ink and metallic glazes give everything a one-of-a-kind finish. Young Artists - Studio Art

9:00 AM - Noon Ages 5-7 \$200/\$215

This summer camp is all about having fun in the studio while learning new art techniques. All of our young artist camps invite students to use their imagination and practice fine motor skills while experimenting with a variety of media- clay, paint, sculpture and collage. No worries here about "getting things right".

Week Three Camps 06/30/2025 - 07/02/2025 (M-W)

Build It - Art Structures!

9:00 AM - Noon Ages 9-13 \$120/\$130

NOTE: This is a 3-day camp. If you like to build, balance and design with all kinds of materials, this is the camp for you! We will experiment with foundations, material characteristics and joining techniques and then have fun with Legos, modular wood pieces and cool packaging forms that inspire art structures that are one of a kind!

Pottery, Painting & Prints

1:00 PM - 4:00 PM Ages 10-16 \$120/\$130

Note: This is a 3-day workshop! The Art Camp Big Three all together - perfect for artists who can't pick just one! We will do exciting projects in one media every day with the artists choice of subject - lino cut print making, acrylic painting, and a functional pottery piece finished with two different glazes. We will learn techniques for each material to make your art one of a kind! Clay, glazes and kiln time all included. Pottery will be ready for pick-up 2-3 weeks after the end of camp.

Young Artists - Music & Theater Arts

1:00 PM - 4:00 PM Ages 5-7 \$120/\$130

NOTE: This is a 3-day camp! Rhythm and movement, art, and theatrics all rolled into a fun camp that will teach young actors skills for the stage and life. Our instructor has built in a positive vibes art break each day to build visual creative confidence. Our theater games and exercises will focus on imagination, listen+respond, teamwork, coordination and simple memorization.

Week Four Camps 07/09/2025 - 07/11/2025 (W-F)

Made2Share - Art Service Workshop

1:00 PM - 4:00 PM Ages 8-15 \$90/\$110

NOTE: This is a 3-day camp. Modeled after our popular art-for-others service workshops, we will be making art together to share with others. JNHS and NHS students may earn 9 service hours during camp. Students will get to choose from meaningful projects including: fleece blankets, inspirational rocks, little free art bags, cat toys, and handmade cards for seniors and veterans, and tie dye T-shirts in the colors of Our Cause so we can spread the word about things that we believe in!

Painting - Studio Art

1:00 PM - 4:00 PM Ages 10-15 \$120/\$130

NOTE: This is a 3-day camp. We will be using acrylics and watercolors in creative styles with your choice of subjects! We will be mixing a variety of art media in our work, creating textured surfaces to paint on and using fiber and wood additions inspired by famous artists. A cool way to expand your art experiences!

Ultimate Art Challenge

9:00 AM - Noon Ages 10-17 \$200/\$215

Think of Food Network's "Chopped" but with art supplies instead of food. Designed for artists who have big ideas and are ready for a creative challenge! Each day, artists get a box of art materials to modify, transform, connect, take apart, or use as intended... and it's up to them to decide what they become. A daily brainstorming session and table full of basics like tapes, glues, scissors and basic hand tools + and extra instructor make this class our most creative yet! Safety goggles provided when needed. Class size limited to 12.

Week Five Camps 07/14/2025 - 07/18/2025

Design & Graphic Art

9:00 AM - Noon Ages 11-15 \$215/\$225

Form and function meet color and design in this fun camp that encourages out of the box creative design solutions. Inspirational challenges start the day with projects that include logos, product and vehicle design, shoe trends and team uniforms, food and beverage branding, and Insta campaigns. We will learn be using illustration markers, colored pencils and technical pens to create our "possibilities portfolio". Each student will exhibit their custom mug design in our summer camp art show!

Film Making

1:00 PM - 4:00 PM Ages 10-17 \$200/\$215

Both experienced moviemakers and those who are just starting out will enjoy this camp! Instructor and local film-maker Jenn Teed and production assistants will help campers learn all about their equipment and demo cool techniques, including Claymation, that will take their films to the next level. On site props and indoor/outdoor settings offer students a chance to come up with imaginative films that tell a story. Students should bring their own film recording device with memory card or cord. Anime & Asian Art

We will create Year of The Snake art and OG Anime characters, invent new bubble tea flavors with graphic design cups, make mini clay figures, and fold origami. This mixed media art camp will use lesson plans designed by our capstone project intern. We will even try some snacks from the Asian market - let us know if your student has allergies.

Clay All Day - Session Two

We will make glowing planetary orbs, constellation sculptures, milky way inspired t-shirts, and create our own versions of some famous night sky paintings! Miniature Worlds

1:00 PM - 4:00 PM Ages 8-15 \$215/\$225

Back again this year! For student artists that love miniature things and scene building, this is your camp! Make a fantasy world, animal habitat, mythological creature cave, art gallery for bugs, alien planet.... if you can dream it, you can make it! We will first design on paper and then move to 3D, creating themed mini worlds, along with tiny inhabitants, their small furnishings, and even art for the walls, all made by you! Artists will use paint, fabric, wood pieces and polymer clay as they design their own 3D mixed media cube box vignettes. Class size limited!

Week Seven Camps 07/28/2025 - 08/01/2025

Michigan Made! Session One

1:00 PM - 4:00 PM Ages 8-15 \$215/\$225

It's back with two different sessions this summer! This art camp takes everything we love about Michigan and uses it as inspiration for some very cool art projects! In this session, we will create Vinyl record art, Pewabic-style clay tiles, Great Lakes Tees, Sanders chocolates, Aurora borealis postcards, Petosky stones and more!

Pottery, Painting & Prints

9:00 AM - Noon Ages 7-12 \$215/\$225

All new projects for 2025! The Art Camp Big Three all together in one great camp - perfect for artists who can't pick just one! We will do great projects in each media with the artist's choice of subject - ink plate print making, acrylic and watercolor, and two functional pottery pieces that we will finish with two different glazes. We will learn techniques for each medium and lots of tricks to make your art one of a kind! Clay, glazes and kiln time all included. Pottery will be ready for pick-up 2-3 weeks after the end of camp.

Sculpture Studio

1:00 PM - 4:00 PM Ages 9-17 \$215/\$225

We'll sculpt realistic and abstract three-dimensional art pieces using clay, wood, wire, and plaster, together with found objects and traditional art materials. An imaginative camp for conceptual student artists. Artists will be taught to use basic shop hand tools safely while creating their one-of-a-kind art: hammer and nails, screwdriver, wire cutters. Safety goggles provided.

Young Artists - Natural World

9:00 AM - Noon Ages 5-7 \$200/\$215

We have rolled a whole week's worth of nature-themed projects into a camp for kids who love the great outdoors! Designed especially for young artists, this mixed media studio class invites kids to use their imagination, and practice fine motor skills while experimenting with a variety of media. Be ready to spend part of the day outside collecting materials and creating!

Week Eight Camps 08/04/2025 - 08/08/2025

Art in Miniature

9:00 AM - Noon Ages 8-13 \$215/\$225

If you love designing and crafting small things and sets, you will love this expansion of our popular Miniature Worlds camp. We will have a different tiny-art focused project each day, using small scene backgrounds, boxes and containers that you customize in your own art style and theme, and then we will add pieces and props, figures and furnishings made from wood, stone, tile, glass, found objects and polymer clay. All materials are included. Class size limited!

The Great Outdoors

1:00 PM - 4:00 PM Ages 7-13 \$200/\$215

Landscape art, insects and natural elements provide the inspiration for our creations in this fun class. Environmental art, natural pigments, stone mosaics, seed bombs, bug houses and cyano printmaking are on the schedule with lots of projects made outside, weather permitting of course! Each student will exhibit a piece in our end of summer Art Show.

Wearable Design & Fashion

1:00 PM - 4:00 PM Ages 10-17 \$215/\$225

Back by popular demand! We will start each class with a themed design challenge, creating a collection of work that students can continue after camp week ends. Some of our projects include upcycled denim makeovers, painted sneakers, and line art icon T-shirts. Students must know how to thread a needle and tie a great knot! Please bring a pair of sneakers (any style) to paint. The instructor will provide the denim, but if you have some to donate, please bring it! We will photograph student designs to display at the end of Summer Camp Art Show.

Week Nine Camps 08/11/2025 - 08/15/2025

Art For The Adventurous!

1:00 PM - 4:00 PM Ages 9-14 \$215/\$225

A new mixed media art camp for student artists who can't decide on just one thing! We will be drawing our inspiration from famous artworks, art trends, nature and pop culture using paint, 2D media, collage and sculpture to create unique art pieces with lots of personality. Each artist will exhibit a piece in our Summer Camp Art Show.

Drawing Studio

1:00 PM - 4:00 PM Ages 9-16 \$200/\$215

A perfect camp for artists who can't stop drawing! We will learn and practice shading, perspective, texture and line using all different kinds of papers and film. We will also experiment with line styles of famous illustrators in projects using graphite, colored pencil, and illustration marker. We will divide into elementary and middle school groups in order to provide the best instruction for all.

Mosaics in Mixed Media

Learn all about making mosaics using different materials - tile, stones, paper, wood, glass, ceramics and found objects. Our instructor will guide students in shape modification and color selection, composition, surface prep and grouting as we apply materials to both flat and 3D surfaces to make one-of-a-kind mosaic art pieces.

Young Artists - Seuss & Friends

9:00 AM - Noon Ages 5-7 \$200/\$215

Designed especially for young artists, this mixed media studio class is inspired by classic books and illustrators like Dr. Seuss, Eric Carle, Lois Elhert and friends. We will be using paint, pastels, clay, collage, and natural materials along with our imaginations, while getting lots of practice using our fine motor skills. No worries here about "getting things right".

Cartooning & Comics - Session Two
